

God separated the light from the darkness and called the light Day and the darkness Night.




He created an expanse between the waters above and the waters below and called the expanse Heaven.




God gathered the waters under the heaven to let dry land appear. He called the dry land Earth and the water Seas. He also created vegetation, plants, and fruit trees with all their seed.
